


Obtaining a Google Maps API Key

You'll need a Google account in order to generate an API key.

Log into your account, or create one, and then navigate to:

<https://console.developers.google.com/>



Click on Project in the upper left corner, then click Create Project

API key
Identifies your project using a simple API key to check quota and access. For APIs like Google Translate.

OAuth client ID
Requests user consent so your app can access the user's data. For APIs like Google Calendar.

Service account key
Enables server-to-server, app-level authentication using robot accounts. For use with Google Cloud APIs.



Use of the Google API is free, but limited to 1,000 requests per 24 hour period.

For high-traffic sites, you may end up exceeding 1,000 requests, in which case the API will not return search results until the 24-hour period is over. You customers will still be able to enter addresses and checkout normally.

The free-usage quota can be extended to 150,000 requests per 24-hour period by verifying your identity by enabling billing on your API account. For more information, follow this link:

Troubleshooting

If the address autofill is not working, or if the Address Line 1 field is being disabled and covered by an exclamation point graphic, follow these steps:

- #1. Access your One Page Checkout app and turn off Address autofill.
- #2. Return to the API console, click Credentials, and then your browser key and verify that your store's checkout page URL is listed under "Accept requests from these HTTP referrers (websites)"
- #3. Verify that ALL THREE of these APIs are enabled: Google Maps JavaScript API, Google Maps Geocoding API, and Google Places Web Service. All three are found in Library, under the Google Maps APIs heading.
- #4. Once you've verified all of the above, return to your One Page Checkout app and re-enable the Address Autofill feature.
- #5. You may need to wait a few moments after adding your site to the list of HTTP referrers or enabling an API.
- #6. If the autofill still isn't working, please access our [Client Portal](#), click on New Request in the upper right corner, and select One Page Checkout.
